When and where will 2020 Entry Forms be available?

Online entry and reference forms are available online at abcfirstcoast.com.

Do I need to get started on the entry THIS early?

Some of the info and documentation required with an entry is easier to collect while the project is underway. Gathering some things now makes it *much* easier to prepare an entry later on.

What kind of info and documentation?

1. Progress photos of your project(s)
2. Photograph rights / photographer releases
3. Safety meeting notes, examples
4. Info about challenges overcome during project(s)
5. Innovations developed through the project(s)

What's required from the Owner and/or Architect?

Letters of Recommendation from the owner and/or architect are typically included in successful entries. Our competition presents an outstanding opportunity to build goodwill with your project owner and architect. Owners and architects are proud of the project, too, and usually happy to recommend it for an award. *Tip: invite them to the awards ceremony. Many owners and architects go onstage with project teams to accept awards...it's great to share the spotlight with them when you're being recognized for Excellence in Construction.*

What's it cost?

The 2020 Entry Fee will be \$395 per entry. **ABC membership is required to participate**, so you must have an active ABC membership in order to take part.

Important Dates:

May 31, 2020 – Projects must be substantially completed to be considered

June 8, 2020 – EIC Entry Deadline

June 15, 2020 – Extended deadline with additional fee

August 14, 2020 – Awards Banquet

September 2020 – EIC magazine published in *Jacksonville Business Journal*

October 2020, exact date TBA – National EIC Entry deadline, TBA
